

## MEMORANDUM

Our next conference call probably will be our final opportunity to discuss our product prior to the NCCUSL Annual Meeting next July. The proverbial lady is getting ready to sing. A revised draft is ready for your review. We will concentrate our attention on the draft revisions which have been made as the result of our November meeting and our February conference call.

It will be extremely helpful if you would prepare a brief note outlining your issues[s] or concern[s] for circulation to the entire group prior to our call.

My thanks to each of you for your time, energy and contributions throughout this process. It has been an honor to work with you. I look forward to working with you as we complete the draft and move on to the enactment process.
