The following report serves as a legislative review of the uniform unincorporated entity acts during the 2021 legislative session.

### The 2021 Legislative Session

Below is a chart of introductions and enactments of the unincorporated entity acts in the 2021 legislative session as of October 18, 2021.

\* Bills introduced in 2021 in South Carolina and Rhode Island will carry over to the 2022 legislative session. Wisconsin legislature meets year-round and is in session from January 2021 to June 2022.

**Additional notes:**

- Maryland: Lisa Jacobs has been working with Steve Leitess and the Maryland Bar Association on RULLCA.
- New Mexico: Jack Burton reached out and said one of our NM commissioners who is also a legislator is interested in pursuing RULLCA over the next few years.
- Minnesota: Commissioner Kim Lowe is asking the Secretary of State and other state offices for feedback on MoRAA.
- Nebraska: MoRAA is also under review in Nebraska. Commissioner Steve Willborn has asked for a memorandum highlighting the benefits of enacting MoRAA that he can share with the Secretary of State.
- Missouri: A bill draft of RULLCA has been prepared in Missouri. I have asked our law clerks to prepare a redline.
- North Carolina: The General Statutes Commission is going to review MoRAA for possible introduction in North Carolina.
