# Veterans Court Act November 20-21, 2015 Drafting Committee Meeting Chicago, IL

# **Issues for the Drafting Committee:**

This is meant to serve as an overview of the issues for consideration before the committee. These issues are addressed more fully in the memorandum sent to the committee.

### A. Eligibility Issues

#### 1. Service Status

- 1a. Should active duty members be included in the Veterans Treatment Court?
- 1b. Should the Veterans Treatment Court include members of the Reserve and National Guard as eligible defendants
  - 1c. Does the veteran have to be a veteran of combat?
- 1d. Does the character of a veteran's discharge matter when considering inclusion in the Veterans Treatment Court?
- 1e. Must the veteran be eligible for Veterans Benefits/Veterans Health Care from the Department of Veterans Affairs to participate in the Veterans Treatment Court?

# 2. Disability

- 2a. Must the veteran suffer from a substance abuse issue to participate in Veterans Treatment Court?
- 2b. Must the veteran suffer from a Mental Health issue to participate in Veterans Treatment Court?
- 2c. Must the veteran suffer from a Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) to participate in Veterans Treatment Court?
- 2d. Are veterans who suffered a Military Sexual Trauma (MST) in service specifically mentioned as veterans who are invited to participate in Veterans Treatment Court?
- 2e. Does the veteran's disability have to have a previous diagnosis to participate in Veterans Treatment Court?
  - 2f. Does the veteran's disability have to stem from his/her military service?

# 3. Crime

- 3a. Does the veteran's crime have to be caused by or related to the veteran's disability?
- 3b. Will the Veterans Treatment Court consider violent as well as non-violent crimes?
- 3c. Will the Veterans Treatment Court permit defendant's charged with domestic violence to participate?
- 3d. Will the Veterans Treatment Court permit defendant's charged with felonies to participate?
- 3e. Will the Veterans Treatment Court permit defendant's charged with a crime involving a weapon to participate?
- 3f. Will the Veterans Treatment Court specifically consider the wishes of the victim of the defendant's crime when determining placement in the Veterans Treatment Court?

# B. Procedural Issues

- 1. What will be the disposition of charges/sentence after completion of the Veterans Treatment Court program?
  - 2. Are there fees for a veteran to participate in the Veterans Treatment Court? 2
- 3. Does participation in the Veterans Treatment Court require the defendant to waive certain rights?
  - 4. Will the Veterans Treatment Court program utilize mentors?
  - 5. Will the Veterans Treatment Court authorize pre-adjudication participation?
  - 6. Will the Veterans Treatment Court authorize post-adjudication participation?
- 7. What are the potential penalties for failure to successfully complete the Veterans Treatment Court program?
- 8. Does participation in the Veterans Treatment Court program require more stringent probation than is normally required?
  - 9. Who refers the veteran to the Veterans Treatment Court process?
  - 10. Whose approval is required for processing through the Veterans Treatment Court?
- 11. Is the defendant required to submit to substance abuse testing while participating in the Veterans Treatment Court?
- 12. Is the defendant required to submit to counseling requirements while participating in the Veterans Treatment Court?
