

## Telehealth Act

#### Change #1

The committee has agreed to add the following to Section 6/7: Board Registration of Out-of-State Practitioner,

(b) A board of this state shall not register an out-of-state practitioner if the practitioner does not satisfy all requirements of subsection (a).

The subsequent subsections need to be re-lettered (c), (d), (e).

#### Change #2

The committee has agreed to revise subsection (b) of Section 9/10: Location of Care; Venue, to read as follows:

(b) A patient [or a patient's] [personal representative,] [conservator,] [guardian,] [person entitled to bring a claim under [cite state's wrongful death action]] may bring a civil action arising out of a practitioner's provision of a telehealth service to the patient in the patient's [county] of residence in this state or in another [county] authorized by law.
