Charlie Trost is a partner in the Nashville, Tennessee law firm Waller Lansden Dortch and Davis, LLP where he heads the firm's State and Local tax practice subgroup. Prior to joining Waller Lansden in 1981 Mr. Trost was Professor of Law at the University of Alabama School of Law. He is a co-author of Hartman and Trost, Federal Limitations on State and Local Taxation, 2d. He is a Uniform Law Commissioner and serves as Treasurer and member of the Executive Committee of the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws. Mr. Trost is a graduate of Vanderbilt University and the University of Alabama School of Law. He received an LL.M. in Taxation from NYU Law School in 1974.
