



A Few Facts about MODEL RULES RELATING TO DISCOVERY OF ELECTRONICALLY STORED INFORMATION

PURPOSE: The primary purpose of the Model Rules is to provide states with up-todate rules for the discovery of electronic documents in civil cases. These new rules mirror the recently adopted amendments to the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure dealing with electronically stored information.
