Dear Martha:

Thank you for submitting to the Committee on Scope and Program a proposal to create a study committee on debt collection default judgments. And thank you for taking the time to attend the Scope meeting and discuss this matter with the Scope members. We were pleased that you could join us. The Scope Committee has received a number of ideas on potential future projects, and each idea is discussed and evaluated by the Scope members for the purpose of determining whether Scope should recommend further research or review on the particular topic.

After discussion, the Committee on Scope and Program recommended that a study committee be appointed. The resolution approved by the Executive Committee provides:

RESOLVED, that the Committee on Scope and Program recommends to the Executive Committee that a study committee be formed to study the need for and feasibility of state legislation on default judgments in debt collection cases brought by third party debt collectors and debt buyers.

We hope to form the study committee soon. Once the committee is appointed, ULC Executive Director Tim Schnabel will be working with the study committee chair to plan the committee's work.
