Some language suggestions

Amending the definition of "cohabitant" and related change to section 104:

Page 2, strike lines 5 through 9 and substitute:

- "(1) (a) "Cohabitant" means one of two individuals:
- (i) who live together as a couple in an intimate, committed relationship that functions as an economic, social, and domestic unit; and
 - (ii) who could be married to the other individual, but is not.
- (b) The term does not include an individual who is married to a third party."

Page 7, line 38, strike everything after "married" and substitute "individual."

Following up on Barbara Atwood's comment:

Page 7, line 33, strike "EXCLUSION" and substitute "EFFECT OF MARRIAGE".

Amending the definition of "termination . . .":

Page 3, line 22, strike "means:" and substitute "means the earliest to occur of:".
