THE UNIFORM PARTNERSHIP ACT (2013 AMENDMENTS)

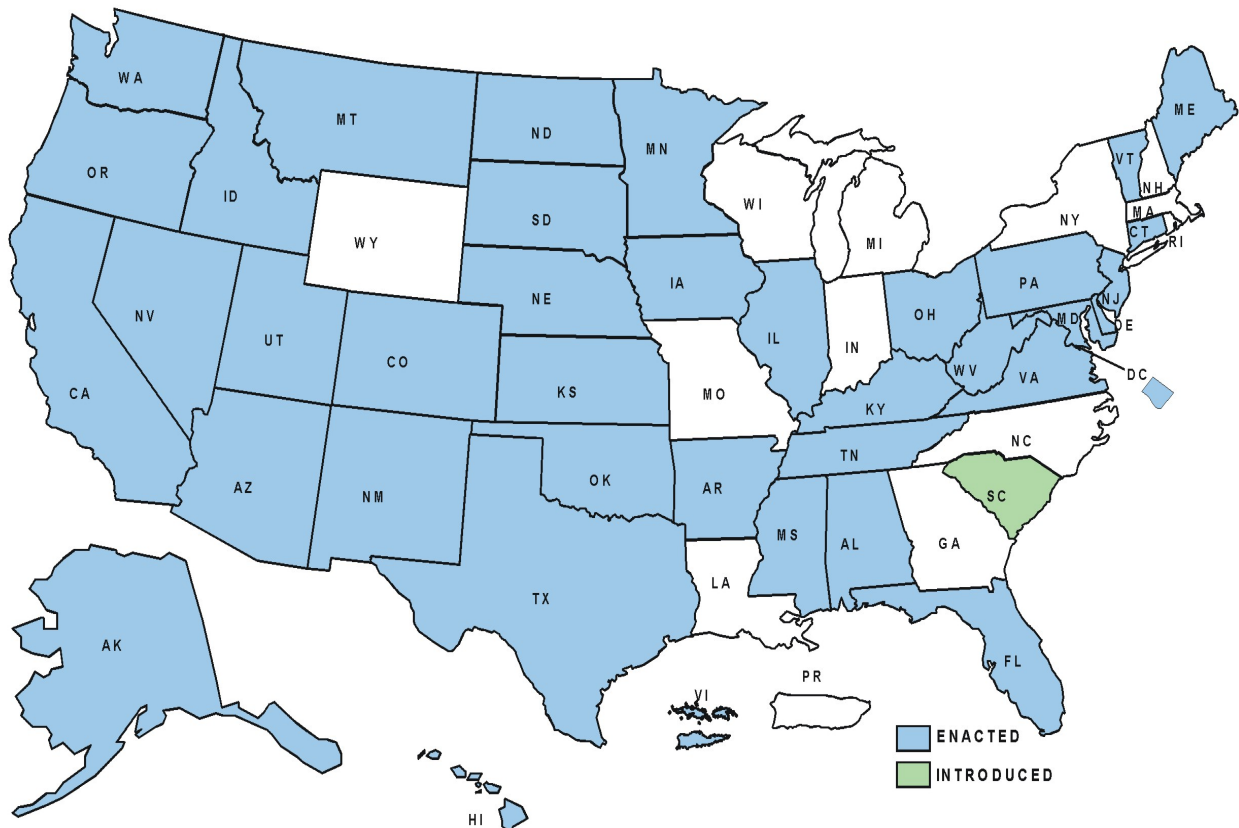
PURPOSE: The Uniform Partnership Act (UPA) establishes a partnership as a separate legal entity, and not merely as an aggregate of partners. The 2011 and 2013 amendments, enacted as part of the Harmonization of Business Entity Acts project, updated and harmonized the language in this Act with similar provisions in other uniform and model unincorporated entity acts.

ORIGIN: Completed by the Uniform Law Commission in 1994, amended in 1996, 1997, 2011 and 2013.
