



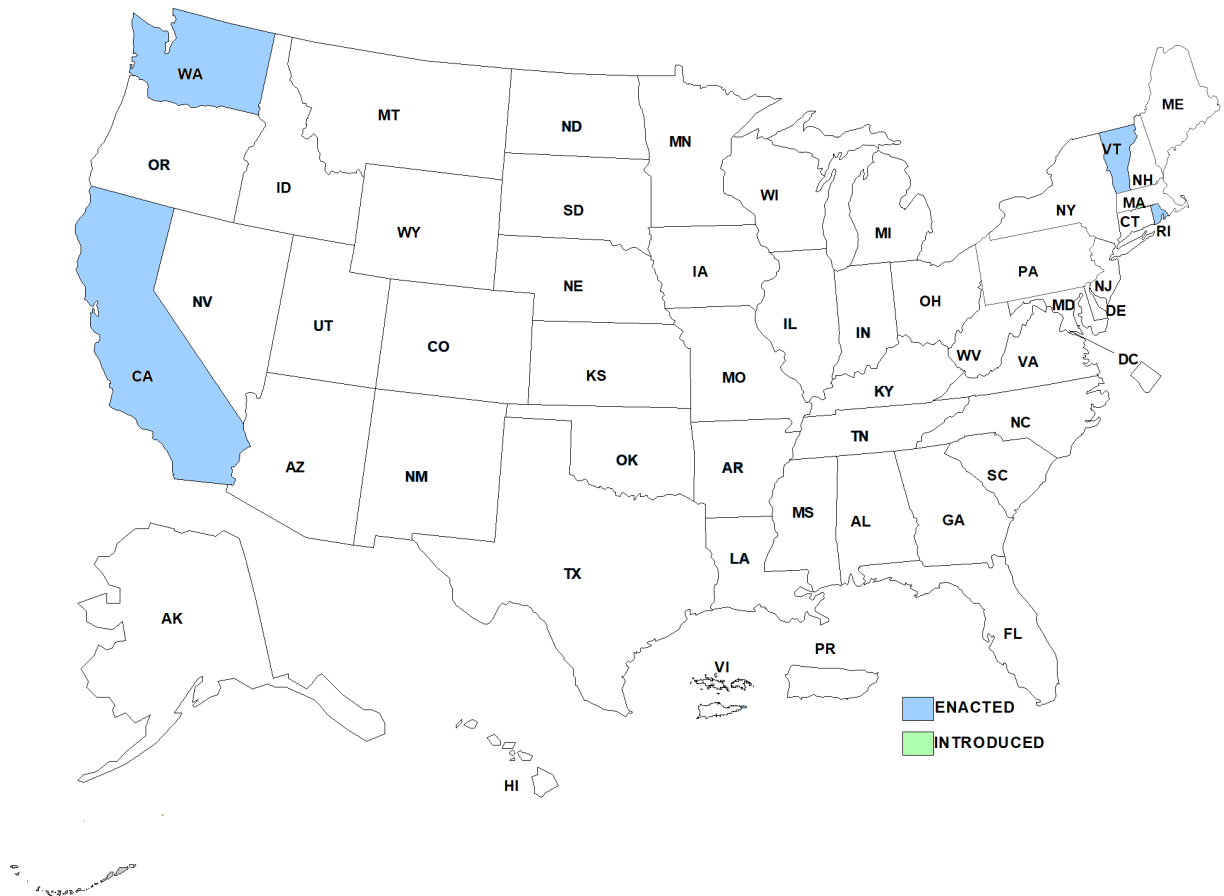

A Few Facts about THE UNIFORM PARENTAGE ACT (2017)

- PURPOSE:** The Uniform Parentage Act (2017) provides states with a uniform legal framework for establishing parent-child relationships. This act updates prior versions of the UPA, last revised in 2002.
- ORIGIN:** Completed by the Uniform Law Commission in 2017.
- APPROVED BY:** American Bar Association
- ENACTED BY:** California, Rhode Island, Vermont, Washington (*List last updated on Oct. 5, 2020*)
