Dear Mr. Sepert:

I am the Majority Leader of the New Mexico State Senate. It has recently come to my attention that the Uniform Law Commission is considering whether to form a drafting committee to review and rewrite the Uniform Division of Income for Tax Purposes Act (UDITPA). I have also been informed that you have been told that state legislators are opposed to the redrafting of UDITPA.

New Mexico enacted UDITPA in 1965, and has been an important part of our corporate income taxes since that time. However, UDITPA is seriously out of date; it must be redrafted to reflect the modern economy and contemporary tax issues. Therefore, I write to indicate that I support the composition of a drafting committee to reconsider UDITPA.
